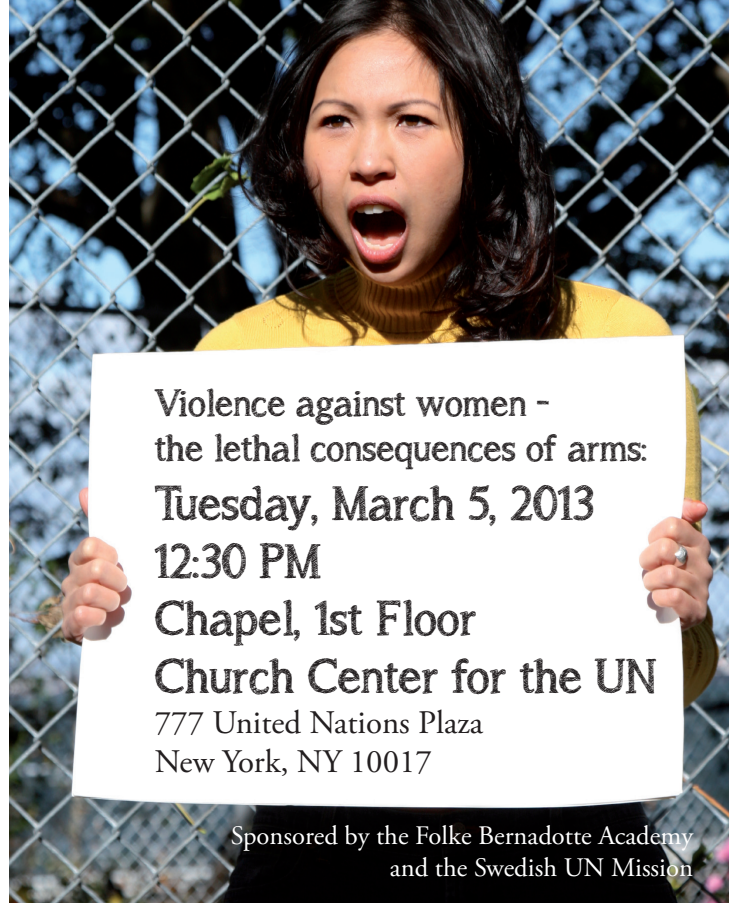
Learn about how women's organisations use resolution 1325 to make the link between violence against women, insufficient arms control, and women's economic and political rights.
