<u>Security Council Open Debate on Children and Armed Conflict</u> 18th June 2015, Security Council Chamber

Statement made by Dato Sri Aman, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, June 2015 President of Security Council

I wish to warmly welcome the Secretary-General, Ministers and other representatives present in the Security Council Chamber. Their participation is an affirmation of the importance of the subject matter under discussion.

I also wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2015/402, which contains the text of a letter dated 1 June 2015 from the Permanent Representatives of Malaysia to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General, transmitting a concept note on the item under consideration.
