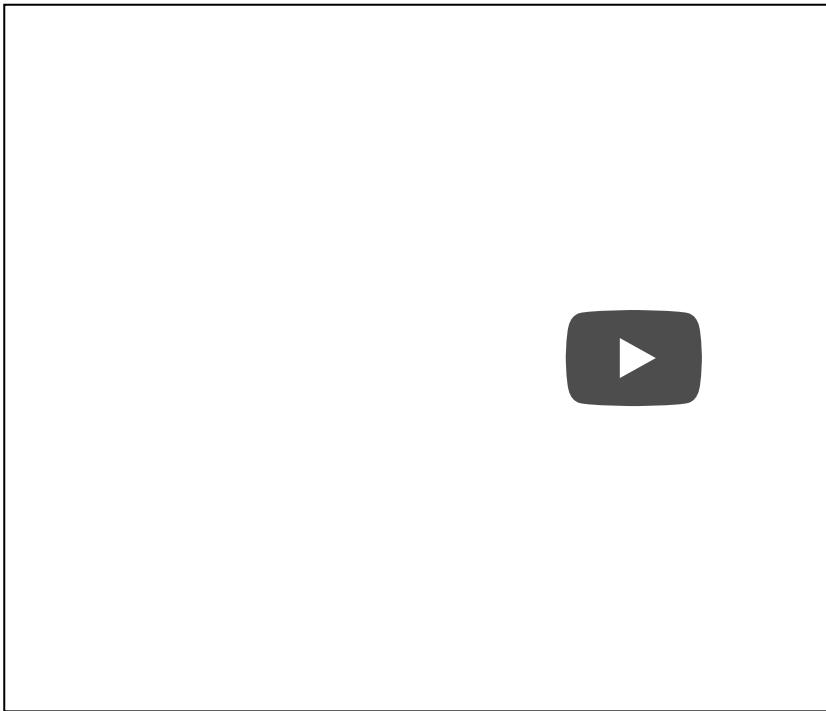

### Discover the 2018 programme here.

We live in a time of increasingly complex social realities. **Violent extremism** takes ever-changing forms. We are often ill-equipped to respond effectively and proactively. Towards an Inclusive Peace is a three-year programme for **peacebuilding** rather than a security-centred response to violent extremism. Participants from international governments, NGOs and development aid agencies discuss the impact of transformation and receive **training in peacebuilding tools**.

### How can acknowledging and repairing the harm help restore the communities and individuals who have suffered from violent extremism?

In 2018, Towards an Inclusive Peace will discuss **restorative justice** and how it can be used for those who have been radicalized and are either being prosecuted or returning voluntarily. The 2018 event will explore how to care for the needs of victims/survivors and reduce the impact of violent extremism while still listening to perpetrators and promoting reconciliation. It will include dialogue, tools of restorative justice, and narrative analysis with a focus on the **world**.



### Who is this event for?

We convene a broad range of participants working in peacebuilding and working at local, national and international governments, NGOs, and civil society. Participants include trainers, mediators, conflict researchers, individual peacebuilders and researchers, and anyone with a desire to learn more about the issue and to explore practical tools that can be used in the field.
