Angola: draft resolution

Women, the girl child and HIV and AIDS

The Commission on the Status of Women,

Reaffirming the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, the outcome documents of the twenty-third special session of the General Assembly, the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development, the HIV and AIDS Political Declarations and Commitments, the HIV and AIDS related goals contained in the United Nations Millennium Declaration and the Millennium Development Goals, in particular the resolve of Member States to have halted, by 2015, and begun to reverse, the spread of HIV,

Recalling all previous resolutions on women, the girl child and HIV and AIDS,

Recalling also General Assembly resolution 66/140¹, as well as the Agreed Conclusions of the forty-fifth session of the Commission on the Status of Women entitled “women, the girl child and human immunodeficiency virus/acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (HIV/AIDS)”

1. Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General ²;
2. Requests the Secretary-General to submit a report to the Commission on the Status of Women at its fifty-eighth session on the situation of women, the girl child and HIV and AIDS, with an emphasis on accelerated actions taken in regard to women, the girl child and HIV and AIDS, in accordance with the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development, the HIV and AIDS Political Declarations and commitments, using information provided by Member States, and the United Nations system.
